The Clinical Psychologist is a key clinical position at Tweddle Child & Family Health Service and reports to the Residential Services Unit Manager. As part of the clinical team, the Clinical Psychologist will provide advanced psychological services and deliver a front-line psychological and support service response to behavioural, emotional and social problems for clients admitted across all Tweddle services.

You will demonstrate sound, evidence based knowledge of perinatal, infant and parental mental health, parent/child attachment and other early parenting psychological issues.

The successful candidate will hold full general registration as a psychologist with the Australian Health Professionals Regulation Authority (AHPRA), appropriate post-graduate qualifications (Masters or Doctoral Degree) in clinical psychology in an Australian Psychology Accreditation Council (APAC) accredited course. Highly desirable is supervisor endorsement with the Psychology Board of Australia (AHPRA) for general psychology supervision.
